




Drawing our rural realities

Title of activity	Drawing our (rural) realities
Theme	Team-building / presentations and getting to know each other.
Learning goals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To exchange about living realities in the different home countries/regions of the participants. To encourage interaction within the group. To get acquainted with each other.
Target audience	National or international groups of young people. Sub-groups of 4 - 5 persons (nationality and gender mixed). No specific age or skills required.
Type of activity	Exercise.
Keywords	Exchange Team-building Rural context
Step-by-step	<p>Members of the group have very various backgrounds and living realities. Getting to know each other also means discussing these realities, their similarities and their differences.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. For 20 minutes, people create / draw together one big common image (on a big sheet of paper) about the living realities in their home countries, <u>without speaking</u> to each other 2. Next, the participants talk for 10 minutes about the final result, the teamwork and the cooperation when drawing the image. 3. The participants discuss their different living realities for 20 minutes, based on the personal "input" of each participant during the drawing.

	<p><i>Debriefing:</i> The sub-groups give a short presentation of their drawings and the main topics of their discussions in a plenary session. After each presentation, there is a question/answer session.</p>
